

COMMUNICATIONS GUIDELINES FOR THE 2022 ELECTIONS

In order to ensure you do not violate state and federal election laws while volunteering please observe the following rules regarding your communications activities leading up to the 2022 election. These restrictions only apply when using COS resources, including your COS email account, your COS volunteer title, the COS mailing list, the COS Slack teams, and the COS Facebook pages. We strongly encourage you to be active in 2022 elections as a private citizen using your own resources. Find candidates who support your values and get involved with their campaigns, then encourage your friends to do the same.

DO	DON'T
Do encourage volunteers to get out and vote <i>E.g. do say "make sure to get out and vote."</i>	Don't tell volunteers who to vote for E.g. don't say "Re-elect our sponsor Sen. Patriot."
<u>Do</u> encourage general political activity in a nonpartisan manner <i>E.g. do say "make sure you get involved with</i> <i>candidates who support your values."</i>	<u>Don't</u> encourage political activity in support of a particular candidate or party <i>E.g.</i> don't say <i>"make sure you vote Republican."</i>
<u>Do</u> use your personal resources to support	<u>Don't</u> use COS resources to support
candidates of your choosing	candidates or political parties
<i>E.g. do post in support of candidates you like on your</i>	<i>E.g. don't post on the COS Facebook pages or send out</i>
<i>personal Facebook page.</i>	<i>an email to the COS list for a particular candidate.</i>
<u>Do</u> lobby candidates to support our	<u>Don't</u> ask people to vote for pro-COS

<i>E.g. do ask candidates to pledge to support our</i>	E.g. don't say "get out and support candidate Patriot.
<i>application if elected.</i>	He's pledged to support COS."
<u>Do</u> provide neutral, nonpartisan information	<u>Don't</u> give special treatment to particular

<i>check out their websites and get involved."</i>	page, check it out and get involved."
