Distribute Convention of States Door Hangers in your Neighborhood Volunteer Activity Plan

Fellow Patriot,

You have chosen to volunteer in a cause to restore our Federal government to what the framers of our Constitution intended using Article V of that constitution, a protection provided by the framers to check a government that has moved beyond its limited and enumerated powers. You can play a most important part in this effort as a volunteer to help us get the job done.

There are a number of volunteer activities that can contribute to our mission as a passed state to "Build an engaged army of self-governing grassroots activists"

This document will help you to know how to conduct one of those activities, namely distributing Convention of States door hangers in your neighborhood.

Often people have not heard about the Convention of States Project but are supportive once they learn about it. The door hanger is a clear plastic sheath that contains a 4" by 9" card (see page 2) that explains how the Convention of States Project is using Article V of the Constitution to gain the approval of 34 states to call a convention to propose amendments to limit federal spending, debt, and regulations. The card lists the Convention of States website where those who are interested can obtain more information and sign the petition as you did.

To obtain the door hangers, you need to contact someone in the state leadership of Convention of States Arizona. If you know who the District Captain is in your legislative district and have their contact information, contact them to obtain a supply of 50 to 100 door hangers. If you don't know who your District Captain is you can find the email address and phone number of the Arizona State Director on the <u>Convention of States web page</u> by scrolling down to the section titled "WHO'S BEHIND THIS THING and click on State Leadership. That will display the contact information for the State Director who will be happy to supply you with door hangers.

At your leisure, walk or drive through your neighborhood placing a door hanger on the front door of homes. You don't need to do all in one day or in one neighborhood, it's up to you. Be sure to check local ordinances and/or HOA's to confirm whether this is prohibited.

We would like to know if you have done this so please let your District Captain or the State Director know. Be prepared for a hearty "Thank you!" because you deserve it, you have made a difference.
