

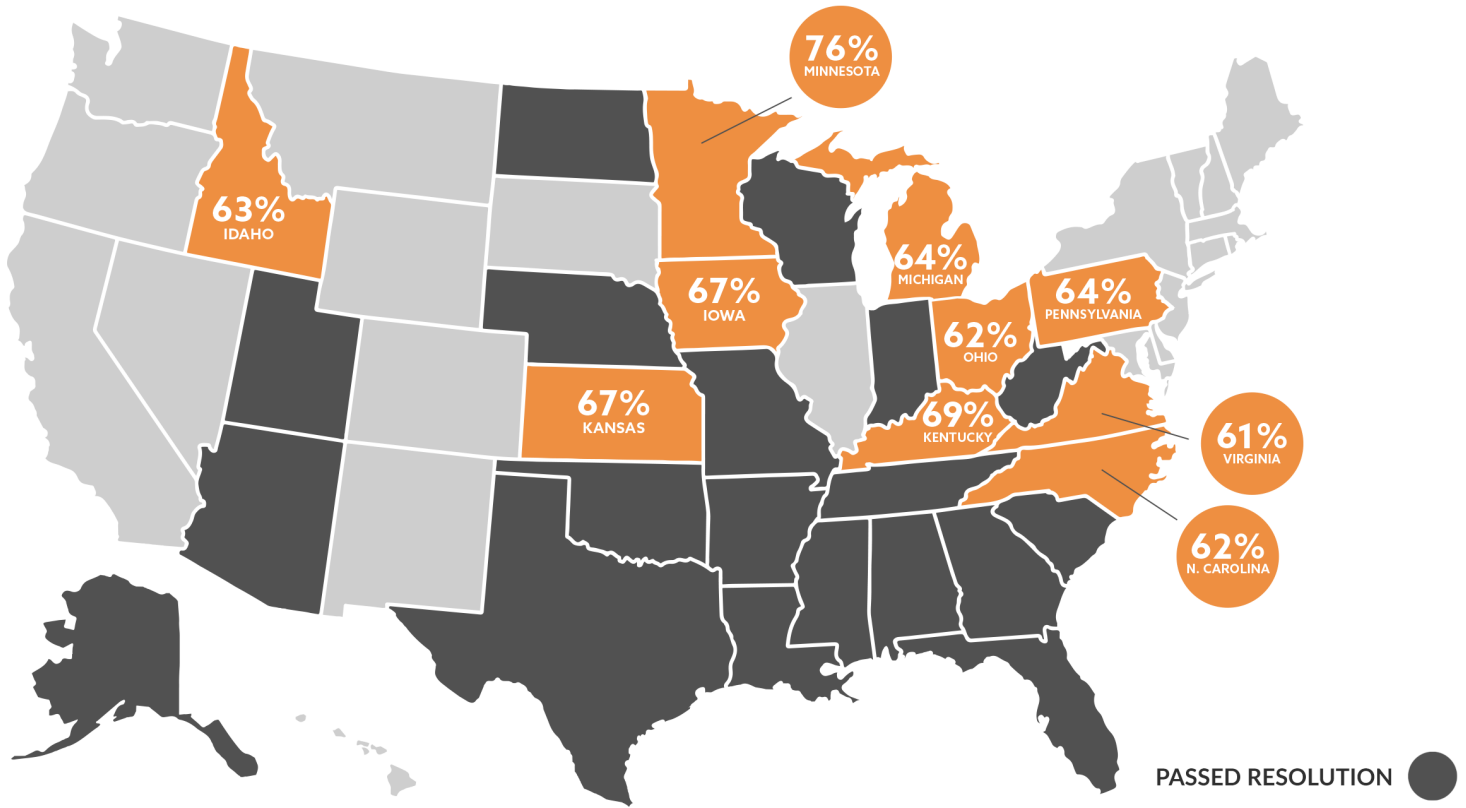


CONVENTION of STATES ACTION

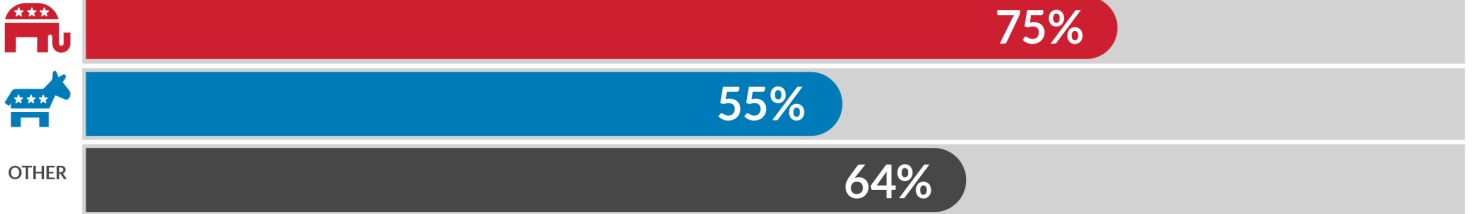

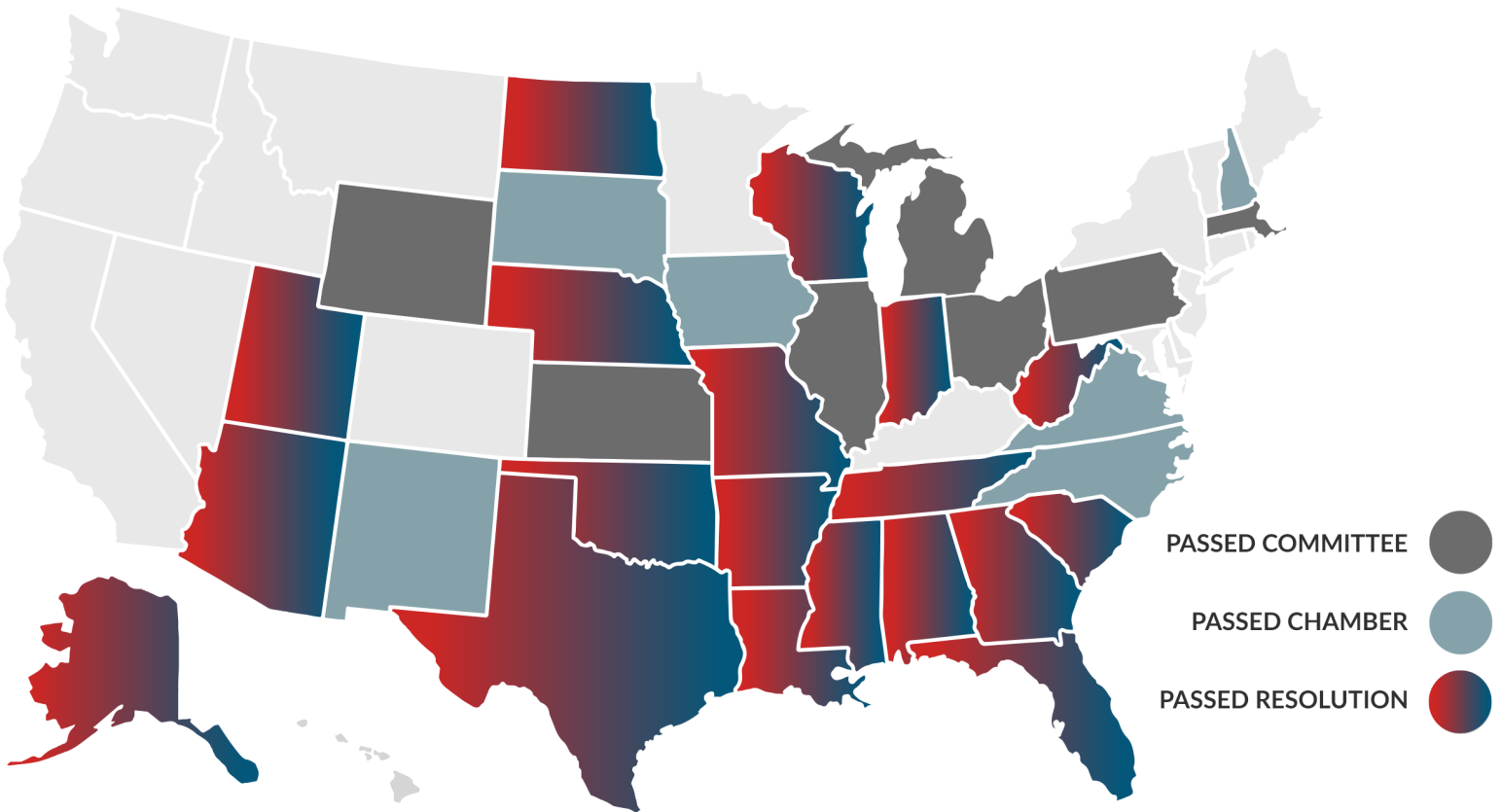
