Daily Prayer Guide for April 2019

Each state is assigned to a specific day for prayer. The color- and number-coding indicates how to best pray for the COS effort there.

- 1: Pray for a volunteer team and COS leadership to emerge.
- 2: Pray for growth in grassroots support and in the COS leadership team.
- 3: Pray for grassroots growth, for increased legislative support, and for sponsors to be identified.
- 4: Pray for the legislative process and for favor in committee and floor votes.
- 5: Pray for continued and increasing grassroots engagement following passage of the COS resolution.
- Arizona: illegal immigration is a humanitarian issue in the heat of the desert summer.
 Pray for a wise and just solution.
 AL-5, AK-5, AZ-5.
- 2 *Arkansas:* pray for Legislative Liaison Randy Alexander's upcoming surgery and extended recovery, and for Katherine DelConte's radio appearance to discuss COS. AR-5, CA-3
- 3 *Colorado:* pray for state legislators to become more open to COS, and specifically for a surge of grassroots growth over the next few months. CO-2, CT-2, DE-2
- 4 *Georgia:* pray for content writing that is happening within the GA team, and for God to provide a new State Director, as current SD Browning Sandusky's job situation has changed. FL-5, GA-5
- 5 *Idaho:* SD Janis Helfman asks prayer for good judgment for legislators voting on controversial issues, that they will support liberty principles. HI-3, ID-3, IL-3
- 6 Hawaii: the COS resolution is being held up in the Senate committee by a former sponsor who seems to have reversed his support. Pray for a breakthrough.
- 7 Nebraska: claim Proverbs 21:1 over Senators Carol Blood, Matt Hansen, Rick Kolowski, and Megan Hunt who are holding up the resolution in committee.
- 8 Joanna Scutari and KrisAnne Hall are speakers who teach on the Constitution but oppose COS. Pray for them according to Luke 6:27-28. IN-5, IA-4

- 9 Ask God to expose corruption and bring about justice in Washington, D.C, according to Job 12:22. KS-4, KY-3, LA-5
- 10 Pray for protection over our technology—servers, web site, and social media accounts. ME-2, MD-2
- 11 *Massachusetts* now has two State Directors—Michael Arnold and Larry Strasner. Give thanks for the growth of the team—and ask for more! MA-2, MI-4, MN-3
- 12 Praise God for our 15 passed states, especially Utah and Mississippi that passed in March. In faith, let's also thank him for numbers 16, 17, 18 and all the way to 34! MS-5, MO-5
- 13 *Nebraska:* pray for a good turnout at the grassroots training session today in Norfolk, Nebraska.
- 14 James 4:2 says we do not have because we do not ask God. So let's ask him for 30 million petition signers!
- 15 Nebraska: pray for all those affected by the blizzard and flooding across the state. Also continue to pray for the committee members mentioned on March 7.

- 17 New Mexico: pray for success in coalition building efforts throughout the state.
